TRUTH & RECONCILIATION COMMISSION

The Truth and Reconciliation Commission, in 2015, released a report detailing the experiences of those affected by the residential school system. The truth telling and reconciliation process acknowledges the injustices and harms experienced by Indigenous peoples and the continued need for healing.

This document, which includes 94 Calls to Action (#18-#24 focus on health), is a commitment to the advancing reconciliation with Indigenous peoples, and establishing new relationships founded by mutual recognition and respect.
